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Surface Preparation

Surfaces must be clean, dry and sound.

NEW SURFACES

For permanent markings ensure that bituminous screeds have cured for a minimum of three months and concrete surfaces for at least one month. Remove any loose particles. Remove any laitance from concrete surfaces.
 NOTE: Paints applied over bituminous screeds less than three months old or over concrete less than one month old are to be regarded as temporary markings with an expected service life of less than six months.

PREVIOUSLY COATED SURFACES

- Remove loose and flaking paint.
- Remove dirt, grime, oil, grease and other contaminants. On concrete substrates (such as parking garages and filling stations) clean with AQUASOLV DEGREASER (GR 1). Use POLYCELL LIQUID SUGAR SOAP for asphalt / bituminous substrates. Rinse thoroughly with fresh water and allow to dry.

N.B.: AQUASOLV must not be used on asphalt / bituminous surfaces, since it is liable to attack the substrate.

Application	 Thin as recommended. Apply a full wet coat to achieve complete obliteration. Should complete obliteration not be achieved with one coat, apply a second coat.
Caution	Always keep containers tightly closed when not in use, since solvents evaporate very fast.
Safety Precautions	 Always keep paint out of reach of children. Ensure good ventilation during application and drying. If accidental contact with skin should occur, wash immediately with soap and water or a recognised skin cleaner. Take care to avoid contact with the eyes. In case of contact, immediately rinse the eyes with plenty of water and seek medical attention. Harmful if swallowed. Seek medical attention and do not induce vomiting. Do not smoke while painting. Flammable. Store in a cool dry place away from heat and sparks. Refer to Material Safety Data Sheet for complete information.
